**Olympic Coach & Olympic Athletes**

**The Following Events will be conducted:**

- Long Jump** **Brittney Reese LJ**  
Brittney is currently the sprint and jumps coach at Mesa CC in San Diego CA. Brittney is the 6 time world champion and London 2012 Gold Medalist and Rio 2016 Silver Medalist in the LJ.
- Triple Jump** **Will Claye LJ/TJ**  
Will is a world champion and a three time Olympic medalist. Will was the first athlete in over 70 years to medal in the LJ and TJ in the same Olympics. He has a foundation called Elevate which helps with giving back to the community
- Sprints** **Jeremy Fischer Sprints**  
Jeremy is the director of the Training Center Track and Field Program at the Olympic Training Site in Chula Vista, CA. He has coached over 15 Paralympic and Able body athletes to Olympic, World, and National Championships. He is the USATF lead instructor and does clinics all over the world.
- Hurdles** **Queen Harrison Hurdles**  
Queen is an Olympian and has been one of the top hurdlers in the world in both the 100 and 400 hurdles. Queen was also the winner of the Bowman award which is the highest award given to a collegiate athlete. She is now a commentator and reporter, as well as being a top hurdler.
- High Jump** **Bryan McBride HJ**  
Bryan is an NCAA champion and many time All-American during his time at ASU. Bryan has high as runner-up at the USATF Championship and been ranked in the top 20 in the world in the HJ. He is half Hawaiian and is also an accomplished long jumper.
- Discus** **Tony Ciarelli:** One of America's premier throws coaches, Tony has been coaching post-collegians and other athletes from around the globe for more than 20 years, he is currently coaching 3 time Shot and Discus Dutch Olympian Rutger Smith, and has coached the following Olympians: Seema Antil ,Brian Blutriech (discus), Erik Johnson, Malissa Weis, Carl Brown. Since 2006, he has been coaching 3-time Olympian Jason Tunks (discus), 2-time Olympian Lieja Tunks (discus & shot), 2003 U.S. World Championship Team member Nick Petrucci (discus), and Sam Lightbody (discus).
- Shot Put** **Rutger Smith (born July 9, 1981 in Groningen)** is a Dutch track and field athlete competing in the shot put and discus throw. He was the first athlete to win medals at the World Championships in both events. He represented the Netherlands at the Summer Olympics in 2004, 2008 and 2012. His personal best of 21.62 m for the shot put is the Dutch national record.
